

<u>History</u>

- **1987:** UNESCO's First International Congress on TVET held in Berlin.
- **1993:** UNESCO launches international project on TVET, hosted in Berlin. **UNEVOC Network**, a global network of TVET institutions, is created.
- **1999:** UNESCO Member States resolution to establish an international centre for TVET.
- 2002: UNESCO-UNEVOC inaugurated in Bonn, as UNESCO's specialized centre for TVET.

- Increase the quality, relevance, attractiveness, and accessibility of national TVET systems
- Promote cooperation among Member States


